- b) **Consignment:** If your donation is chosen for auction, you will receive 50% of the proceeds from its sale. The consignment option does not include **Summer Shindig** tickets.

For both options, please use the attached form to provide us with the details of the artwork. Forms must be completed in entirety to be considered and/or accepted. We also need to know the work's reserve price/minimum bid and an estimated price range in which you expect the work to sell. **Donations/consignments of artwork valued at more than \$1,500 will not be considered**.

Schedule

May 19: Deadline to send digital images of artwork and completed applications. Clear images must be submitted in JPEG format to communications@gmoa.org. If the file is too large to attach to an email, you can send it through a cloud storage link (Dropbox, Google Drive, etc., but please do NOT send it through social media platforms). The email must include the attached form and an artist statement or bio. Please save the image files using the artist's last name and 1-2 keywords from the artwork's title. For example, if the artwork title is "Summer Shindig," I would name the image file asher_summershindig. The GMoA staff and Summer Shindig event committee will jury the submitted images.

May 24: Artists will be notified of their acceptance into the silent auction via email by this date.

June 8: Deadline for artwork to be delivered to the Museum. **All work must be completely dry, framed, wired, and ready to exhibit.**

June 20: Artwork will be displayed at the Summer Shindig event at GMoA, where guests will place bids.

June 29: Deadline for unsold artwork to be picked up at the Museum. If you need to make special arrangements regarding the pickup or delivery of your unsold work, please inform Sim Asher via email. Artists shipping artwork to the museum must cover the shipping expenses and return shipping of artwork.
